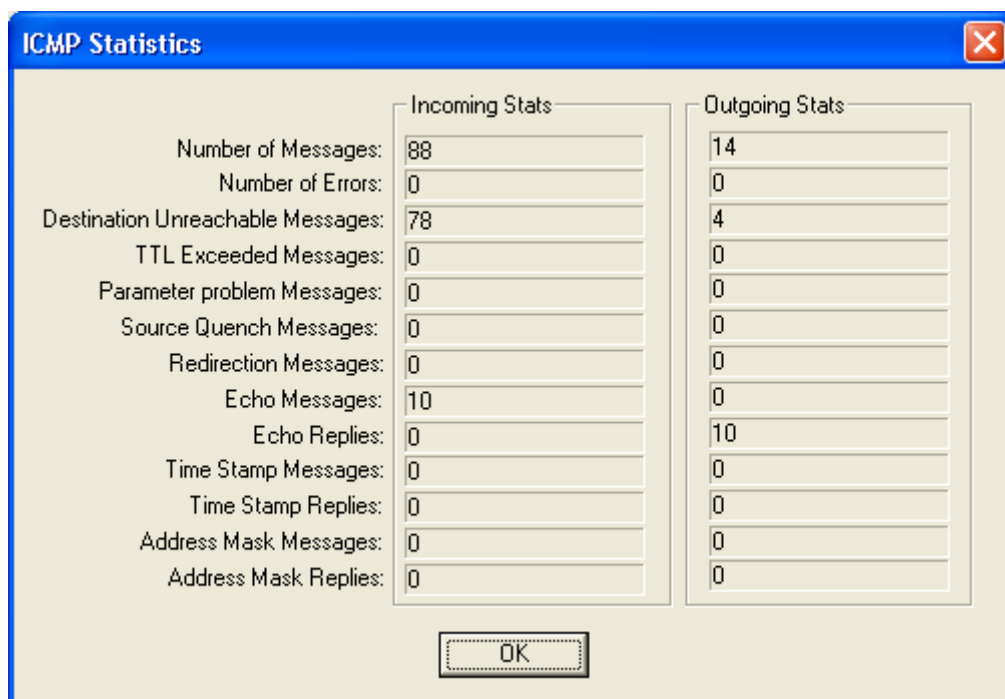


ICMP Statistics
